# **Diocesan Assembly**

The Diocesan Assembly was held on Friday evening and Saturday at Federation University, Mt Helen. The assembly included delegates from all parishes, representatives from religious congregations, diocesan committees, health services, aged care, school communities and the Catholic Education Office, CatholicCare social services, organisations such as the St Vincent de Paul Society, Catholic Women's League and Australian Catholic University, as well as the priests of our diocese. The focus was on the theme of leadership and governance, looking at 'How Does God want us to lead and govern for a Missionary Synodal Church in the Diocese of Ballarat'.

Both the Australian Plenary Council and the recent Synod of Synodality encourage us to develop leadership and governance in a synodal way. We pray that the diocesan assembly will bear fruit that will bring blessings to everyone in our diocese. May we learn more and more to walk together, guided by the Spirit of Christ.
