Preparing for the 2024 Diocesan Assembly

How does God want us to Lead and Govern for a Missionary and Synodal Church in the Diocese of Ballarat?

Synod 2021 2024 For a synodal Church The Diocesan Assembly will take place at Federation University, Mt Helen in the Albert Coates Building commencing Friday evening November 15th and Saturday 16th 2024.

After the formation in preparation for the 2024 Ballarat Diocesan Assembly, the three Parishes of our Ministry District- Ballarat East (& Buninyong), Bungaree (& Clarkes Hill & Dunnstown), Gordon (&Ballan & Springbank) have delegated Rachel Allen & Cathy Prunty (Ballarat East Parish), Dianne Reynolds & Damian Ryan (Bungaree Parish) and Mark Conlan & Sue Daly (Gordon Parish) as the six delegates

from our Ministry District. There are 29 Parishes across the Diocese – from the Murray to the Sea that have delegates to the Assembly together with delegates from Catholic agencies, Catholic organisations, entities, Religious Congregations, Diocesan Boards, Commissions, Councils and Panels as well as all Clergy of the Diocese, including Fr's Justin & Matt. Following the Plenary Council of the Catholic Church in Australia and the recently concluded Synod on Synodality, the methodology of the Assembly will include conversations in the Spirit with all delegates to table groups of up to eight with a facilitator trained and commissioned for this ministry.

The Assembly will be facilitated by Sr Karon Donnellan RSM (Leader of the Sisters of Mercy Australia and Papua New Guinea and previously a parishioner of Ballarat East). The 17 table groups of up to 8 delegates will be facilitated by those who many who belong to our parishes - Jo-Anne Bond, Donna Bryce, Rosemary Canavan, Mark Hogbin, Martin Ryan and Loretta Sheppard. In addition to the Parish delegates and the table facilitators, others from parishes of our Ministry District who are delegates are Bridget Aitchison (ACU), Matt Byrne (DOBCEL), Anne Eskdale (Diocesan Pastoral Planning Panel & Personnel Advisory Board), Sr's Berenice Kerr & Veronica Lawson (Sisters of Mercy). Jane Collins has been central to the preparation of the Assembly as well as colleagues in the Pastoral Ministry Office Julie Boyd and Fran Peterkin. In all we have many from the Parishes of our Ministry District that are significantly involved, not only the six delegates but also as delegates from other entities, table facilitators and parishioners who work for the Diocese in the Pastoral Ministry Office and those who seek to support them.
