It was in October 2021 that Bishop Paul issued the Decree to announce that the parishes of Dennington, Koroit, Port Fairy Warrnambool West and Warrnambool were now the new parish of Star of the Sea, South West Coast.

In July 2022 the parish of OLHC Warrnambool East joined the Star of the Sea Parish.

The recent change of Fr Abraham returning to the Cathedral Parish on July 1st necessitates further reflection on how to serve the pastoral care of parishioners. The Bishop is not in a position to replace Fr Abraham.
