A Call for Prayerful Discernment

Last Tuesday evening in Koroit, members of the Pastoral Leadership Teams met with the members of the newly formed Parish Pastoral Council to discern how best to arrange our worship times now that we have been reduced to two priests.

It is hoped that Port Fairy, Koroit and the three Warrnambool communities will have Mass each weekend. Purnim continues with their Mass on the 2nd Sunday of the month while a 'retired' priest is available.

I will 'sit on' the various responses that were made (both verbal and written) for another few days and all going well, our new Mass schedule will be finalised and made public next weekend.

The new Mass schedule commences on the weekend of 6/7 July.

There are many variables involved. No easy solutions.

The last thing I want to do is delete Masses. However, we can only respond with the personnel at our disposal at the time.

I would encourage all Pastoral Leadership Teams to assist in the formation of Lay-Led Assemblies in their respective communities because they could be called up at any time eg. through sickness, accident or the annual vacation of the clergy.

I seek your understanding and your continued generosity and faithfulness as we minister to God's people.

Some general comments:

- *a sensitivity to the elderly & those who travel
- *a healthy tension between the Mass 'I desire' and what's best for the whole parish
- *the well-being of the clergy was noted
- *the importance of community... as against just attending Mass
- *a weekend Mass at each church while it's still possible
- *there was an openness to Lay-Led Assemblies when required e.g. clergy vacation or sickness
