Reflection

Paul asserts his authority and castigates the Galatians for abandoning the Gospel he'd preached to them. This Gospel was revealed to him directly by God, not by human beings.

What matters is 'not obedience to the law, but faith in Jesus Christ', with whom he has been crucified, is now his life. Faith in Christ makes all the baptised - 'Jew and Greek, slave and free, male and female' - one in Christ Jesus. Christ has set them free, and free they must stay.

God help us with ideas, those thoughts which inform the way we live and the things we do. Let us not seize upon ideas, neither shall we hunt them down nor steal them away. Rather let us wait faithfully for them to approach, slowly and gently like creatures from the wild. And let them enter willingly into our hearts and come and go freely within the sanctuary of our contemplation, informing our souls as they arrive and being enlivened by the inspiration of our hearts as they leave. *Leunig*

Reflection

The Lord's prayer is a summary of a long prayer the Jews pray every day, called the 18 Benedictions. A prayer leader proclaims, 'Glorified and sanctified be God's great name throughout the world which he has created according to his will. May he establish his kingdom in your lifetime and during your days.' And the assembly responds, 'May his great name be blessed forever to all eternity.' In the Lord's Prayer, Jesus injects something new: his disciples are to address God with a familial term Abba, the Aramaic equivalent of 'Daddy' or 'Papa'. Jesus tells his disciples to maintain this special relationship with the Father, which is consistent with the Christian belief that in Jesus we have become God's adopted children. St Paul reiterates this special privilege: 'As proof that you are children, God sent the spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying out, "Abba, Father!"'

The first three have to do with God and his glory; then come requests for our human needs: provision, pardon and protection. The petition for forgiveness is further developed to bring home to us that God's mercy and our own mercy towards one another are interlinked and interdependent.
