## New Envelopes 2016-17

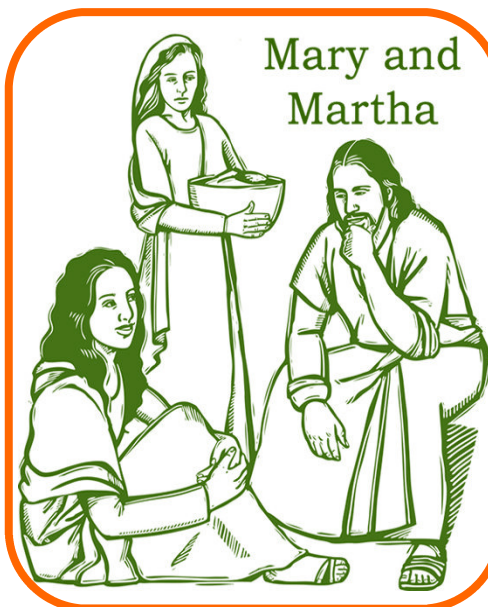
