

To bring the College of Cardinals up to its full voting strength of 120 (Once they turn 80. Cardinals remain as advisors to the pope, but they are unable to vote for the new bishop of Rome) Pope Francis has created some new cardinals, and continuing his policy of bring representatives of smaller countries into the College of Cardinals. Last time, the batch include a bishop from Tonga and a bishop from Myanmar. This time he has include bishops from Papua-New Guinea, Bangladesh and the Central African Republic. None of the above countries has ever had a Cardinal previously. He has also named as Cardinals some who are over 80. as has become the custom since Vatican II. These Cardinals become part of the College of Cardinals, advisors to the pope, but not Cardinal-electors.
