#### National Count of Attendance at Mass & Sunday Assemblies in the Parishes of Gordon and Bungaree

The parishioners of Bungaree and Gordon have been asked to participate in the national count during the month of May. The national count is conducted in the same year of the Australian Census so that the information collected can be most effectively used. The count is conducted over the *first four consecutive Sundays* (& Saturday evenings) in May. Counting over four Sundays ensures that fortnightly and monthly Masses are not overlooked. This year, parishes will also be asked to provide estimates of the age and sex of those who attend Mass and Sunday assemblies.

#### Novel coronavirus (COVID-19)

We ask all parishioners to abide by the rules for Victoria's COVID safe settings. All parishioners who have a mobile phone are required to register via the QR code when entering the church. If you do not have a mobile phone you <u>must</u> register by completing the sign-in form before Mass. Please remember to follow the guidelines for safe ways to celebrate and practice faith including – get tested and stay home if you feel unwell, Save COVIDSafe by washing your hands regularly, having a face mask with you and wearing it when required, coughing and sneezing into your elbow and keeping at least 1.5 meters from others.

#### Get vaccinated for the common good

Vaccination against COVID-19 is a morally good thing, providing protection for the person vaccinated and the wider community. Some COVID-19 vaccines are associated with ethically questionable production and research practices, but Pope Francis and the Australian Bishops have advised that it is morally permissible to receive any vaccine made available.
