LAY MINISTERS: IMPORTANT

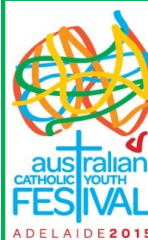
Please read

The very earliest name for the Mass was the Breaking of Bread. Bread broken and shared. The idea is that we all receive from the one loaf. We represent this by having a quite large host at Sunday Mass, broken usually into 24 parts, that being the way, for convenience, the large host is marked. At Mass, these pieces broken from the large host should be given to those coming to receive Communion first, before any of the little hosts. Most of the Lay Ministers here seem to avoid given them out at all. Please amend your ways.
