Last weekend we reflected on the gospel passage where Jesus sent his disciples to a mission with authority and power. In today's we see that the disciples returned from their mission and made report to Jesus what had happened in their mission. Seeing them tired and exhausted, with almost no time to eat, Jesus sends them to a deserted place for some rest. But the people get there ahead of them. Instead of getting irritated at this turn of events or resenting this disturbance of their privacy, Jesus attends to the people, being moved with pity for them, thus allowing the Apostles to get their needed rest.

Jesus suggests that we take some time off our hectic schedules and everyday activities to be with God in prayer and in silence. This gives us the opportunity to reflect on our life and listen to God speaking to us. In prayer, we are recharged with God's grace and strengthened by God's wisdom and words as we open our minds and offer our hearts to God.

Our resting with God or our communion with the Lord must lead us to be more committed to the mission of God and to dedicate ourselves to the service of the people of God. Our prayer to God must be translated into good works for our brothers and sisters. Our moments of rest should recharge, refresh our faith and motivate us to continue our mission of witnessing the Lord. So let us pray to our Lord to strengthen our faith by the power of the Holy Spirit so that we may be able to serve the people with humility and loving care. -Neville
