ITEM FOR AGM

Since I retired, I have not attended the Parish AGM. However, Fr Mick McKinnon has agreed with a request from to discuss with you our Parish Celebration of Good Friday. Attendance at Red Cliffs is becoming smaller each year, which is a bit of a mystery. The Good Friday celebration is not a Mass, though, towards the end, we receive Holy Communion from the Holy Thursday celebration. For a long while, I have myself felt uncomfortable about the Good Friday Liturgy. It is really designed for monasteries, which can manage the beautiful Latin chants written for Good Friday. The fact that it starts and ends without a hymn, and various other elements probably combine to make people feel a bit lost at the celebration. I have already been sounding some parishioners out about the celebration. I suggested an earlier hour for it; but that met with no positive response.

At the moment, I'm thinking that we start with a hymn, and the Cross is brought in as part of the Entrance, rather than as a second entrance after the Liturgy of the Word. The Good Friday Celebration would as now, have a Liturgy of the Word, with the longer Prayer of the Faithful (6 prayers or 11), followed immediately by our coming up to venerate the Cross; then our receiving Holy Communion, with as hymn at the end. I had suggested Stations of the Cross to replace Liturgy of the Word; but I have abandoned this idea. I would welcome comments prior to the meeting. *Flags*
