Today we celebrate the 2nd Sunday of Easter, this Sunday is also known as a Divine Mercy Sunday.

We say God is love and His greatest attribute is mercy. Because we are weak and have a sinful nature, God shows His love to us as mercy. The Risen Christ shows mercy to His disciples when on meeting them together for the first time, after they almost to a man abandoned him, He grants them mercy by saying to them: "Peace be with you" not once but twice, and a third with Thomas present. Having made them experience His mercy, Jesus gives them the Holy Spirit and commissions them to grant mercy to others: "Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them".

Through the death and resurrection of Jesus, God brought salvation for humanity. We, too have received God's mercy. Like the Apostles we are also commissioned to be the ambassadors of God's mercy. So let us proclaim and pass on that mercy to other people by sharing it with them, by showing mercy to others through forgiveness and acts of compassion.
