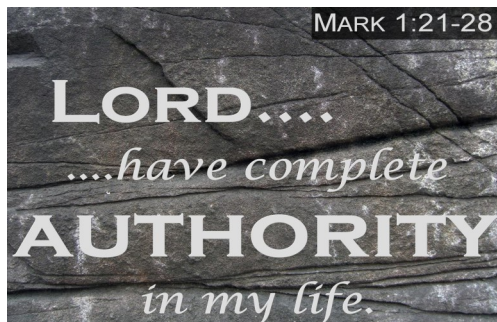

Towards the end of Lent the statues are covered with purple as well. There are no bells. The Alleluia is neither sung nor spoken during Lent. There is no Gloria & no Creed.

In the Romano-Flanagan Rite, we have a special way of beginning Mass each Sunday.
