ADVENT FORGIVENESS MASS

For the Advent Forgiveness Mass on Sunday 6th December, we write out our sins, and, during the Forgiveness prayers we bring them up to the urn on the sanctuary where they are burnt during Communion. We also bring our gifts for children to the Christmas tree DURING THE FORGIVENESS PRAYERS NOT BEFORE MASS. After Mass Vinnies collect and sort them, ready for distributing.

Vinnies' Christmas Tree: The St Vincent de Paul Society will have their Christmas Tree in the Sanctuary next Sunday with tags saying 'Boy 7-years old' etc. attached to them.
