### BENEDICTION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT

I was asked recently why we never have Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament here. When I was in Maryborough, we instituted on the First Friday of each month, Mass at 10.00 am, Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament until Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament at 5.15 pm, followed by evening Mass. I was able to establish this same practice in Edenhope, where I was stationed for two and a quarter years after I left Maryborough. From Edenhope I went to Hamilton. I had to abandon the practice after about 8 months, because it did not receive enough support.

From Hamilton I went to Donald. There I established on the First Friday, Mass at 9.30 am followed by exposition of the Blessed Sacrament concluding with Benediction at 12 noon. From Donald I came to Red Cliffs. There did not seem any point in trying to do something like that here, because there were only 3 regulars at weekday Mass.
