Dear Friends,

We see in the gospel that the people seek Jesus, just because they see in him the answer to their material needs and physical hunger. Impressed by the multiplication of the five loves and two fish which we had reflected on last weekend, they are motivated by free food and enticed by the thought of getting even something more from Jesus. Jesus can surely give more than bread. But Jesus exhorts them to work not for food that perishes but for the food that endures for eternal life, which the Son of Man will give them. Beyond physical bread there is bread that brings eternal life. He himself is this bread from the Father, the living bread that gives eternal life.

Jesus made it clear to them when they asked him: "What can we do to accomplish the works of God?" His reply was: the work of God is to believe in the one He sent. Then they asked him again to provide some signs that they could see and believe. So they asked him: what can you do? Our ancestors ate "manna: in the desert, as it is written: He gave them bread from Heaven". Jesus told them that He was the bread that came down from heaven gives life to the world. They asked Him to give that bread always.

This bread from heaven is now made visible at the sacrament of the Eucharist. As God fed his people with "manna" in the desert, God is offering us the bread of life, who is Jesus, as He assures us in today's gospel. In our celebration today we too can ask the Lord to give us the daily bread that would give us strength and courage to witness the work of God, namely to love, care and show mercy the people who are poor and needy like Jesus - Neville
