Adding some strokes and finishing touches to the picture of God which was her life, **St. Teresa of Calcutta (Mother Teresa)** reminded us, "Spread love wherever you go: first of all, in your own house. Give love to your children, to your wife or husband, to a next-door neighbor. . . Let no one ever come to you without leaving better and happier. Be the living expression of God's love, love in your face, love in your eyes, love in your smile, love in your warm greeting."

Today's gospel we see, Jesus gives us the commandment of love and asks us to remain in his love. So united with Jesus in love, we keep his commandments too, in the same way he loves us. We must share with others his love for us. This is our call. How do we love others? Do we have a standard for love? Yes we do, Jesus has openly demonstrated the love that he has for us by laying down his life for us. He says: 'No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends'. From this we clearly understand that Jesus' love was not selfish or conditional but a sacrificial love. This sacrificial love is not to demand anything in return but to remain in His love.

This love is for who and what a person is. God loves us in spite of our mistakes, in spite of our sins and infidelity. God loves us for what we are and whoever we are. God's love is not selective or exclusive. He loves us with all our limitations and weaknesses. Gods loves all sinners and saints alike. He calls us friends and asks us to remain in his love. He made the initiative to redeem us and gave us the commandments. If we remain in his love we can be fruitful. So let us take his call sincerely and bear much fruits for his kingdom. Hence during our celebration let us ask the Lord's mercy and remain in his love to fulfil his commandment of love as he has loved us............Neville.
