Baptism of the Lord

Characteristically, Luke chooses to highlight Jesus' prayer rather than his baptism. It's while Jesus prays that the heavenly voice announces him as God's Beloved.

The same pattern-deep prayer paving the way for divine blessing - is found

Transfiguration. Luke sees the same dynamic at work in the apostolic community. After Jesus' ascension, Mary, other women and the apostles devoted themselves to prayer in the upper room.(Acts 1:14)

It's on this praying community that the Pentecostal Spirit descends and lets the Gospel loose in the world. Luke would have us realise that it's by laying our minds and hearts open in prayer that the glory and power of our baptismal spirit will be revealed to us.
