**The Face of Mercy
 – Pope Francis**

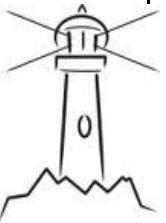

Easter is the name Christians give to the Sunday that celebrates Jesus' resurrection. East is the direction where the **sun rises** each morning. The word **Easter** means **dawn, the awakening** of a **new day**. Mary Magdalene discovers Jesus' tomb empty **at dawn**. God creates a promise of life **beyond death** and summons us to a future beyond human **imagination**, to be co-workers of a **new life with him**.

Passion Sunday

In the Gospel story of the first Palm Sunday, we hear that the owners of the ass had only to be told, "The Master has need of it," (Luke 19:34) to give the animal gladly. Do I give as readily to the Lord's work?

"The Lord God has given me a well-trained tongue that I may know how to speak to the weary a word that will rouse them," (Isaiah 50:4) says Isaiah in today's first reading. The gifts God has given us are likewise given for the good of others. How am I using my gifts?
