BISHOPS PASTORAL LETTER ON "ASSISTED DYING" PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

Our Victorian bishops are again speaking on behalf of the most vulnerable in our society in releasing another Pastoral Letter on 9th October (on 9/10/2017) about proposed legislation euphemistically named "Voluntary Assisted Dying Bill 2017." This endorses suicide rather than committing greater funding for better aged care facilities and end of life care.
