**Making Connections:** What assists you to become more 'pure of heart' and to strengthen your commitment of Christ? It may be the Rosary, volunteering, attending Mass. Think about what helps you grow in faith and keeps you focussed on following Jesus.

Did you Know?: Points of interest and Catholic lore. Judaism at the time of Jesus was made up of a number of different groups of adherents like Sadducees, Pharisees and Essenes. These groups sometimes held different beliefs; for example, the Pharisees believed in the resurrection of the dead while the Sadducees did not. This did not cause undue problems however, because what held all Jews together was a belief in one God, in the Law, in their election as God's chosen people and a common worship centred on the Temple in Jerusalem. Their unity was a stronger force than their diversity.

The washing of the hands by the priest at Mass is a symbolic gesture of a desire for a pure heart. **Exploring the Word:** Becoming obsessed with external practices and rituals is not what God asks of us. The Prophet Micah famously put it this way: This is what Yahweh asks of you: only this, to act justly, to love tenderly and to walk humbly with your God. (Micah 6:8)

**Symbols and Images:** The heart is a symbol of the whole person, the seat of the emotional life. People can be 'good-hearted' or 'hard-hearted'. Jesus is critical of those who are externally virtuous but do not have their hearts in the right place. The heart is also the symbol of love. Truly loving others and living for them is an act from the heart.

**Daily Prayer:** Lord God, as we welcome your saving word, help us speak it in the generous service of those most in need, for this alone is religion pure and undefiled. Let the praise on our lips resound in the depths of our hearts, the word you have sown, the word that has taken root within

us to sanctify and renew our entire lives.

Marriage Tip: Is life overwhelming right now? Take a deep breath, and remind vourself of your blessings, especially your faith and your marriage. This too shall pass!

**Vocational View:** Thank God our struggles of faith can be ultimately overcome through prayer, perseverance and love. 'Do what the word tells you.' Be doers of the word.
