ST. VINCENT DE PAUL. (1581-1660). We recall the magnificent life of the "saint of charity", the total dedicated "Monsieur Vincent". A parish priest near Paris, Vincent worked against the physical and moral evils of his time. Galley slaves, abandoned babies, prostitutes, victims of war and the poor – all came under his mantle of generous care. Together with St. Louise de Marillac, he founded the Congregation of the Mission (called Vincentians). The patron of all charitable societies. Vincent de Paul's life and ideal of charity still inspire the Church.
