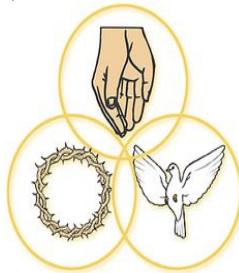
End of Financial Year
