

**NEW DEACON FOR ST AUGUSTINE'S PARISH:** After ordination as a deacon there is a nine to twelve month parish placement before priestly ordination. Bishop Paul has announced that Matt Restall will be appointed to our parish and Bill Lowry to Redan parish in Ballarat. They still have their final year of study to complete and will need to return to Corpus Christi College seminary, Carlton from time to time – thus why parishes not too distant from Melbourne have been chosen for their appointments. We're grateful that, after Fr Tuyen with us in 2015 and Fr Mark in 2019, we'll be again pleased and privileged to welcome another fine young man to our parish and look forward to supporting Matt throughout his final year of preparation for priestly ministry.

**ST AUGUSTINE'S SCHOOL BUILDING GRANT:** Our member for Mallee, Anne Webster, has announced a \$1.6 million Federal Government building grant for St Augustine's School. Along with our local contribution, this will enable a building project of \$2 million to proceed for upgraded classrooms, library and admin facility that will greatly benefit all students.
