EXTRAORDINARY MONTH OF MISSION OCTOBER 2019. For the Extraordinary Missionary Month, the Holy Father has chosen the theme “Baptised and Sent: The Church of Christ on a Mission in the World”. There are four dimensions, specified by the Pope, to live more intensely the journey of preparation for the Extraordinary Missionary Month October 2019: 1. Prayer; 2. Witness of extraordinary people of mission; 3. theological reflection/formation; and 4. Charity. Catholic Mission is endeavouring to address each of them through the various initiatives and activities, local, national and global, to encourage people to prayer and to participate in something ‘extraordinary’ for mission. ST. BRUNO (1035 – 1101) Born in Cologne, Germany, Bruno was well educated and taught theology for over 25 years. Yearning for a solitary life of penance and contemplation, he joined several companions in a solitary quasi-community life. Bruno settled in the Chartreuse Alps and there founded a contemplative monastic order, the Carthusians. After a brief time as a papal advisor, Bruno returned to his hermitage in Calabria (south Italy). He was canonised in 1514.
