The former Colac man is setting out to complete the Pint to Pinnacle in Tasmania, which will see participants run 21.2 kilometres up Mt Wellington in Hobart, with more that 1200 metres of evelvated climbing.

Sam in completing the challenge on November 20, as part of a Carrie's Beanies 4 Brain Cancer Foundation team, of which he is general manager and committee member. There was a one donation Sam McGuane received during a 2019 brain cancer fundraiser that has stayed with hem ever since. It was from a father who had lost his nine-year old daughter Chloe to the disease three years before 'Everyone's got \$5' was the message the man left along with his \$5 on line donation.
