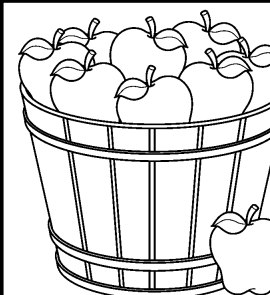
ST COLMAN'S MORTLAKE & ST THOMAS' TERANG
