Bishop Emeritus Kevin Manning, the second Bishop of Parramatta, died yesterday, aged 90. Bishop Manning led the Parramatta Diocese during a period of rapid growth from 1997 to 2010. "He has served the Lord and his Church with courage, creativity and fidelity for many years. We pray that he will now enter fully into the Lord's joy and peace," Australian Catholic Bishops Conference President Archbishop Timothy Costelloe said. "We express our appreciation for his generous and faithful commitment to the work of the Bishops Conference over many years." He was

instrumental in building bridges with other Christian communities and people of other faiths, especially Western Sydney's Muslim community. Bishop Manning was a staunch campaigner for social justice, seeking to improve the rights of workers, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders, migrants and refugees and women.
