ST. PETER CLAVER. Born in Spain, Peter Claver vowed to become a missionary in America. Ordained as a Jesuit in Columbia, he spent his life serving the African slaves. Peter would meet slave ships at Cartagena and enter the infested holds to care for the dead, dying and sick. He instructed and baptised the slaves, and ministered to them on the plantations. Peter Claver, who called himself "the slave of the blacks forever", died on 8th September, 1654 and was canonised in 1888.
