MEMORIAL MASS FOR BISHOP MULKEARNS. The proposal to offer a Memorial Mass for Bishop Mulkearns has been reconsidered in the light of the level of distress that this proposal has prompted. A public gathering for Mass in an environment of protest would raise concerns for public safety, exacerbate the pain and suffering of victim survivors and compromise the occasion as one of prayer. The Mass for Bishop Mulkearns was proposed in line with the Catholic practice of prayer for those who have died. However, the adverse reaction to the proposal has been listened to and the concerns heeded, so the Mass advertised for Monday 16th May at St Patrick's Cathedral, Ballarat will now not proceed.
