The Mass of Holy Thursday usually includes the Washing of Feet after the homily and a Procession with the Blessed Sacrament to “a place of repose”. In line with directions given by the Congregation for Divine Worship for the time of pandemic, the Washing of Feet and the Procession with the Blessed Sacrament may be omitted. The Congregation has indicated that the Blessed Sacrament could simply be taken to the tabernacle after communion as usual. This would not rule out providing some time for people to stay for quiet prayer after the Mass, as is the custom particularly on Holy Thursday. For **Good Friday**, the Congregation for Divine Worship provided a prayer related to the time of pandemic. The Good Friday ceremony includes Veneration of the Cross. I propose that people be invited to come forward to venerate the cross by bowing before the cross rather than by touching or kissing the cross. I also note several general provisions that go beyond Holy Week. I remind everyone of the directive that, during this time of pandemic, communion should be received in the hand rather than on the tongue. Also, while Covid is still occurring frequently in the community, there should be no sharing of the chalice, those distributing Holy Communion should use hand sanitiser prior to distribution and not touch anyone when giving a blessing, and holy water fonts should still be empty. May the peace of Christ be with us all as we continue our journey through Lent and come to celebrate Holy Week and Easter. God bless you all. **Bishop Paul**

Meeting for Holy Week @ Daylesford

Many thanks to Bronwyn, Carmel, Denise Mc, Hilary, Ian, Jude, Millie, Rose, Sandra and Trish who met with Fr Justin to plan for the Holy Week liturgies at Daylesford. Those who would like to assist with the music and singing at these liturgies are very welcome to join in preparation and are invited to gather after 10.30am Mass today April 3rd. Holy Week will see the recommencement of the Procession of Gifts (Offertory) and the Collections (Good Friday for the Holy Places, Easter Sunday the 1st and 2nd Collections). The ministries of reader and holy communion are still open to ensure that as many as possible are able to join in full, conscious and active participation in the liturgy. There is a special invitation to parishioners worshipping formerly at Blampied to join the liturgical ministries in Daylesford for Holy Week and to join the rosters when they recommence in May. Those whose are rostered will be invited to give written consent to their contact details being shared with others rostered so that replacements can be arranged. After Easter Sunday, it is proposed that there be monthly morning teas in the Parish Centre after 10.30am Sunday Mass. More discussion will be invited in the Easter Season.

As part of our Lenten journey, the request for a Penitential/Reconciliation Service was made. Parishioners are invited to gather on **Sunday April 3rd (today!) at 5.00pm** for Evening Prayer with Examination of Conscience, Litany of Confession and Reflection. Following the liturgy, Fr Justin will be available for the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Mass with the Sacrament of Anointing will be celebrated on **Wednesday April 6th at 10.30am** with morning tea to follow.
