Mass is capped at 57 people

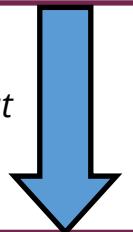
You must check in via QR code or manual sheet

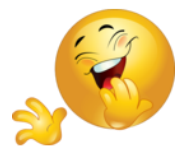
Ballarat Diocese Lay Pastoral Ministry Virtual Learning Program
