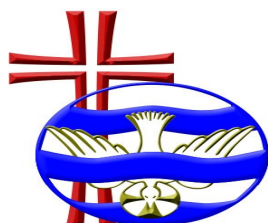

Sisters of the Good Samaritan – Study and Mentoring Program


