Fear

When scripture uses the term fear, it
tends to fall into one of two meanings.
When used in the context of 'do not be
afraid' or 'fear not', it is a command to
not be daunted by the woes and trials
that the world imposes. The other
use tends to be a command that we
should fear God. In this context, the
word does not mean to be frightened
of God but rather to show proper
reverence. To fear God is to stand in
wonder and awe rather than to cower
and hide. So, fear God, but do not be
afraid!
