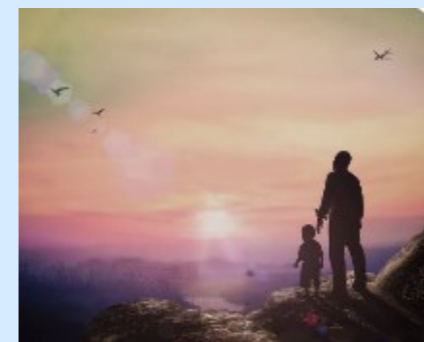

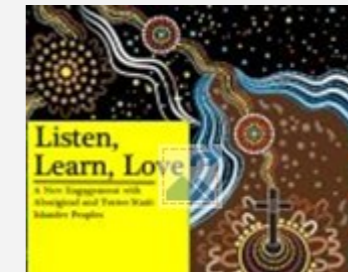
### Happy Father's Day
