Advent has a two-fold purpose:

It is the time when the Church longs for the coming of the Lord. In this longing the Church looks in two directions, so to speak.



- Reflecting on the Lord's first coming as a child born to Mary in Bethlehem
- Looking forward to his second coming as Son of Man at the end of time.

Advent can be overwhelmed by the attraction of Christmas. Let's give some space to the Season of Advent.

It's our spiritual preparation time during which we ready ourselves for the feast of Christmas and the Christmas Season.

The Old Testament prophecies of hope and deliverance which we read during Advent, did not come at the hour of Israel's triumph - they were born from defeat and exile. John the Baptist comes from desolation of the desert to proclaim the coming of the Lord. And the Lord of all the earth is born in poverty and obscurity.

Communion from the Chalice (Excerpts from the Bishop's letter)

Dear People of the Diocese,

I consider that it is time to reintroduce the option of communion from the chalice ...

The common aim is to allow the faithful to receive Christ under the appearance of wine as well as under the appearance of bread, following the words of Jesus "Take and eat" and "Take and drink". In this way, communion is more clearly a sign of sharing in Christ's heavenly banquet.

Anyone feeling unwell should refrain from taking the chalice.

May the revival of this practice enrich our celebration of communion with Christ and with one another. (Bishop Paul)
