Lay leadership in a parish community: 2018

The Catholic Church in Australia is in CRISIS, in dire need of a fundamental change in the present hierarchical model of Church governance. Pope Francis is calling for a church from the bottom up, asking for dialogue and decision-making from all of God's people, especially those who have been hurt or exploited. Child sexual abuse by clergy and the on-going cover-up by the leadership of the church has shocked and disillusioned the lay faithful. Protection if the church's image was seen as more important than the pastoral care of victims, their families and indeed the perpetrators. Some bishops have distanced themselves from the crimes and shown to be inadequate for the necessary reform, renewal and healing.

The Australian Plenary Council 2020 offers an opportunity for creative responses and invocations that will address some of the areas in need of reform. In the important discussions and discernment in preparation for this Council, lay faithful, priests and bishops are invited to enter into dialogue with those Pope Francis has asked us to listen to: namely the poor, the abuse victims, survivors, divorcees, gays, refugees, women and disaffected Catholics.
