However, a small number of people nominated by Parishes have yet to complete the training, even after several reminders. In view of the importance of this training, I have decided that the time has come to set a deadline for this training to be completed. I ask that all those who have been nominated by their Parishes for this training complete the training by October 31 this year. If, for whatever reason, any do not complete the training by that date, they should suspend their ministry in the Parish until they complete the training. Thank you for your cooperation in the vital task of ensuring that our Parish communities are safe places for everyone. God bless you all.
