Focus on the Scripture



This passage can sound very heartless if directed to the destitute, those without the necessities of life.

So, where is the emphasis to be sounded? 'Do not be worried about your life. But you are to worry about others, others without adequate food or clothing.' In fact, later in this Gospel it is made clear that our eternal destiny depends on our provision of the necessities of life for others.

But, do I *really* believe that my 'Heavenly Father' knows what my basic needs are and will prompt others to provide for me if I can't manage myself?

The first reading brilliantly correlates with this passage. The prophet Isaiah gives us a *maternal* image of God: 'Does a woman forget her baby at the breast ... Yet even if these forget, I will never forget you.'

God is more motherly than the most maternal of mothers.

Being made in the image of God, if each of us expressed the maternal traits of God vis a vis others then they would not need to be anxious about food or clothing.

We could pause for a moment to set our hearts on the Kingdom in which the maternal imaging of God can flourish.
