Diocesan Assembly - was held on Friday evening and Saturday at Federation University, Mt Helen. The assembly included delegates from all parishes, representatives from religious congregations, diocesan committees, health services, aged care, school communities and the Catholic Education Office, CatholicCare social services, organisations such as the St Vincent de Paul Society, Catholic Women’s League and Australian Catholic University, as well as the priests of our diocese. The focus was on the theme of leadership and governance, looking at ‘How Does God want us to lead and govern for a Missionary Synodal Church in the Diocese of Ballarat’.
