#### **Priest Appointments from July 1**

Hello Everyone,

In view of recent health problems, **Fr Gary Jones** has proposed that he conclude his time as Parish Priest of Hampden Parish on June 30 this year and I have accepted this proposal.

I offer my thanks to Fr Gary for his service to the Hampden Parish and to all the communities that he has served throughout the diocese. From July 1, Fr Gary will join the ranks of our Senior Clergy.

To provide for the pastoral care of the Hampden Parish, I am appointing **Fr Neville Stanislaus** as Parish Administrator of Hampden Parish, in addition to his current responsibilities as Parish Priest of Camperdown and Timboon. I am appointing **Fr Jim McKay**, currently Assistant Priest at the Cathedral Parish, to be Visiting Priest for the Hampden Parish. These appointments will take effect from July 1 and will continue for the remainder of 2024. I will make longer-term appointments to the Hampden Parish after further consultation over the coming months.

Also from July 1, **Fr Abraham Thomas MST** will move from his role as Assistant Priest in the South West Coast Parish to the role of Assistant Priest in the Cathedral Parish.

**Deacon Xuan Cay Trinh** is due to conclude his studies at Corpus Christi Seminary at the end of this semester. I am appointing Deacon Cay to the Sunraysia Parish for the coming months. He will serve as Deacon in the Sunraysia Parish from July 1 till November 3. He will then make final preparations for his ordination to the priesthood, which is scheduled for Saturday, November 23.

I thank Fr Neville, Fr Jim, Fr Abraham and Deacon Cay for generously accepting these appointments. May their ministry in these parishes bring joy to them as well as to the people they serve.

gave Your priestly people a share in Your redeeming sacrifice.


Hear our prayer for the sanctification of our priests.

### 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Diocese of Ballarat – Formation
