# **The Most Holy Trinity**

On this feast of the Holy Trinity we pause to reflect on the great mystery of God who has drawn so close to us. In Jesus, God assumed our human condition. In Spirit, we have become God's children able to address God by the intimate title 'Abba, Father!'

This feast, first celebrated in monastic communities in the ninth century as an expression of praise to the triune God, was extended to the entire Western Church in the fourteenth century.

It celebrates the mystery of God's self revelation through the experiences of the people of Israel, the disciples of Jesus, and the Christian people since Pentecost.

# Our Lady, Help of Christians

Last Friday (24<sup>th</sup> May) we celebrated the feast of Our Lady, Help of Christians. Mary was chosen as Patroness of Australia in 1844. In the Opening Prayer for this feast, the Church prays that through Our Lady's intercession, God will "grant wisdom to our leaders and integrity to our citizens", so that "under her protection, Australia may be granted harmony, justice and peace".
