# WHY DO WE DO THE THINGS WE DO?

Why do we have a church calendar? Life can be hectic. So many dates to juggle: school holidays, birthdays, grand final day, election day ... As a Church family, too, we have a busy calendar. We call it the liturgical year because it is comprised of the various Christian feasts and seasons over the course of the year. The Church year begins with Advent. Easter is the pinnacle of the Church year. The readings in the Sunday Mass vary according to a three year cycle referred to simply as Years A, B and C. This calendar allows us to focus as a community on the mysteries of our faith in some kind of systematic and unified way.

The Sundays in Ordinary Time commence on Sunday, January 19 with the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time.
