


St Francis Xavier Chapel (1865) and Cemetery at Eganstown is the only Catholic Cemetery in the Diocese and only one of three in the state of Victoria, with Kilmore and Sandon

Over many years churches were built throughout the Central Highlands Parish including St Peter's Daylesford (1863), St Paul's Glenlyon (1869), St Joseph's Blampied (1871), St Patrick's Korweinguboora (1871), St Mary's Newlyn (1879), St Alipius' Bullarto (1882), Sacred Heart Lyonville (1883), St John the Baptist Yandoit (1884 – 1992), St Bernard's Hepburn (1912 relocated from Franklinford). St Michael's Primary School was relocated from Daly Street to Smith Street Daylesford in 1994.

The Presentation Sisters came in 1892 to Holy Cross Convent, staffing schools in Daylesford, Blampied, Eganstown, Glenlyon and Korweinguboora
