Professional Standards

In April this year, the Professional Standards Office sent Parishes a new safeguarding training module called "Safetrac", requesting that this training be completed by those parishioners who have been nominated by Parishes as having particular ministries in the Parish that require them to do this basic training. A large number of people have completed this training, either online or on paper, however, a small number of people nominated by Parishes have yet to complete the training, even after several reminders. In view of the importance of this training, Bishop Paul has set a deadline for this training to be completed, asking that all those who have been nominated by their Parishes for this training complete the training by October 31 this year. If, for whatever reason, any do not complete the training by that date, they should suspend their ministry in the Parish until they complete the training.
