SHARED REFLECTION

EXAMINATION OF CONSCIENCE

The Assembly is now invited to make an examination of conscience. This may be done in silence or by using the examination of conscience below. One reader alone may read the questions or two readers might alternate. Allow a brief period of silence between each one.

Sit

Leader:

- How have I failed to worship God in private and communal prayer?
- Have I tried to grow in the life of the Spirit through prayer and the reading of the word of God?
- Do I trust God's goodness and providence, even in times of crisis and doubt?
- Do I fulfil my commitments as a member of my faith community?
- Do I look for opportunities to share the Good News of Christ in my daily life, especially with my family and friends?
- How have I failed to use the gifts of God in daily living?
- How have I failed in my relationships with others?
- Do I share my time and my treasure with others in need?
- Do I fail to speak out on behalf of the poor or the oppressed?
- Do I use the earth's resources wisely?
- Do I truly forgive others, and work to reconcile relationships that have been wounded?
- Do I purchase a lot of material goods that I don't really need?
- Do I love all people freely?

• Do I work to overcome my own prejudices, and encourage others to do the same?

If read aloud, this Examination of Conscience should conclude with a period of silence, so that each person may personally examine his or her conscience.

RITE OF RECONCILIATION

GENERAL CONFESSION OF SINS

Kneel

Leader: Christ our Lord came to call sinners into his Father's kingdom.

Let us now make an act of sorrow in our hearts and resolve to avoid sin in the future.

After a brief period of silence, all say together:

All: I confess to almighty God, and to you, my brothers and sisters, that I have greatly sinned in my thoughts and in my words, in what I have done and in what I have failed to do, through my fault, through my fault, (striking the breast) through my most grievous fault; therefore I ask blessed Mary ever-Virgin, all the Angels and Saints, and you, my brothers and sisters, to pray for me to the Lord our God.

LITANY OF REPENTANCE

Stand

Leader: Lord our God, you know all things.

You know that we want to be more generous

in serving you and our neighbour.

Look on us with love and hear our prayer.

Leader: Give us the strength to turn away from sin. Lord, have mercy.

All: Lord, have mercy.

Leader: Help us to be sorry for our sins and to keep our resolutions. Lord have mercy.

All: Lord, have mercy.

Leader: Forgive our sins and have pity on our weakness.

Lord, have mercy.

All: Lord, have mercy.

Leader: Give us trust in our goodness

and make us generous in serving you. Lord, have mercy.

All: Lord, have mercy.

Leader: God does not want the sinner to die, but to turn to him and live.

May he be pleased that we have confessed our sinfulness and may he show us his mercy as we pray in obedience to his Son.

LORD'S PRAYER

All: Our Father....

Leader: Almighty and eternal God, you sent your only-begotten Son

to reconcile the world to yourself.

Lift from our hearts the oppressive gloom of sin, so that we may celebrate the approaching dawn of

Christ's birth with fitting joy.

We ask this through Christ our Lord.

All: Amen.

May the God of peace fill your hearts with every blessing. May he sustain you with his gifts of hope and consolation.
