

WORD OF GOD SUNDAY



One of the primary ways in which we honour God's Word in the liturgy is by faithfully listening to the proclamation of the readings and the homily, and by discerning the various ways in which God's Word applies to our lives. An important point to remember here is the Second Vatican Council's insight that Christ's presence is recognised in the actual "proclamation" of the Word, when the Church believes that Christ is present and speaking to those assembled through the words of the Church's minister [Sacrosanctum concilium (1963) art. 7], rather than in the physical book itself. At Masses across our Ministry District next week, those who proclaim the Word of God will be commissioned once again for their ministry as well as those who compose the Prayers of Intercession. Our parishes are blessed with biblical scholars who offer weekly reflections on the Word of God that are included on our newsletters - we will ask a blessing on them as well. Let us embrace Sunday of the Word of God to help us launch our new year with a deeper and richer encounter with the Risen Lord.
